## **COLORECTAL CANCER SIGNS + SYMPTOMS**

- Blood in your stool, bleeding from the rectum, and/or change in the appearance of the stool
- Change in bowel habits or blood in the toilet after having a bowel movement
- <sup>z Z</sup> Unexplained Fatigue or Weakness
- Anemia
- Unexplained or Unintentional Weight Loss
- Persistent Cramps or Low Back Pain, cramping pain in the lower stomach
- Feeling Bloated, or a feeling of discomfort or an urge to have a bowel movement when there is no need to have one
- Sometimes colorectal cancer presents with no symptoms at all

Colon cancer symptoms can be confusing. Stomach ailments or a change in bowel habits are common. They don't always mean that you have a serious condition such as colorectal cancer.

Contact your provider when symptoms persist or you have more than one

Nearly 90% of colorectal cancer is easily treatable when diagnosed in its early stage. Get educated and get screened on time.
